

 - Sub category :- 'X' denotes those graduates who have passed Examination under 10+2+2 or 10+1+3 scheme.
 'Y' denotes those graduates who have passed Examination under 10+2+3 scheme.
 - (a) Ord. 212—A candidate who failed at the M.A. Previous examination, but passed in atleast 50% papers prescribed for the exam. in accordance with the rules given below in clause (i), (ii), (iii) and (iv) shall be eligible to re-appear in the failing paper(s) of Previous Examination alongwith the Final Year Examination.

 (iii) For reckoning 50% of the papers at the M.A. (Previous) Examination, Practical will be included and one practical will be counted as one theory.
 (iv) If the number of the papers prescribed for the previous examination is an odd number, it shall be increased by one for the purpose of transmitting 50% of the papers.
